I agree to receive notices of meeting, accounts and all other Club communications by email to the address I have given above or any other address I notify to the Club in writing.

I acknowledge that sailing is a dangerous sport the risks of which include drowning, injury and exposure. I assume those risks voluntarily and agree that the Club is not able to prevent them arising. Without limiting the foregoing, I also acknowledge that there are risks in the sailing club environment including slipping, tripping, contact with moving spars and equipment, and falling from unguarded catwalks or other structures.

In consideration of the Club accepting my application I hereby release and indemnify the Club and its officers, contractors and agents from all claims and liability in respect of injury or death and any other loss or damage arising directly or indirectly from anything I do or undertake at the Club or in events it organises or is associated with. This release and indemnity extends even to anything caused by negligence of those released and indemnified. If I am the owner or skipper of a vessel competing in a Club event I agree that I will have current at all times a liability indemnity insurance policy (property damage and loss, injury

and death) for at least \$10million and I will produce evidence of this to Club's officers on request.

If I wish to store watercraft in the Club premises I accept that I do so on the terms of the attached.

Storage Terms

(these terms apply to storage of all watercraft within VYC premises)

I offer to take a licence of a boat storage rack for the craft referred to in the schedule (or such replacement for it as the Club approves in its discretion) and all its associated equipment (together or separately '**the craft**'). The licence commences on the date shown in the schedule. I agree to do so only on the following terms:

1. the Club can decide which rack I must use from time to time.
2. I must keep the rack and craft within the allocated space and I must ensure that the craft is identifiable as owned by me. I must not store any fuel or other inflammable or dangerous substance in the rack or the clubhouse.
3. the Club may cause the craft to be moved whenever deemed necessary for operational reasons by the Club.
4. this agreement is subject also to the by-laws of the Club as prescribed from time to time.
5. either I or the Club may terminate this agreement by one month's notice in writing. The Club may also terminate immediately upon non-payment of the licence fee. Without limiting in any way the Club's right to terminate as it sees fit, I understand that craft that have entered and paid racing fees to compete in Club races take precedence over non-racing craft in the use of available racks. Where the Club terminates this agreement the Club will rebate any licence fee paid in advance on a *pro rata* basis.
6. to pay in advance the charges fixed by the Club from time to time, being initially the amount per annum or per month shown in the schedule when membership fees are due or at such other times as the Club requires. I agree that the Club may vary the charges by one month's notice in writing.
7. that the craft is to remain at my sole and absolute risk and that all insurances in respect of same will be my sole and absolute responsibility. I acknowledge that I have satisfied myself as to the suitability of the rack for the craft and I acknowledge that I must ensure the safe and proper use of the rack at all times.
8. on termination of this agreement, I must immediately remove the craft from the Club, and in the event that I fail to do so or cannot be contacted easily, I also authorize the Club's officers to remove the craft from the Club to such place as the Club may decide and to dispose of it for such consideration (or without consideration) as the Club may see fit. I further agree and authorize the Club to apply the net proceeds of disposal (if any) after payment of all the Club's expenses to payment of any outstanding amount due to the Club under this agreement. These rights of the Club are in addition to any other rights it has at law.
9. in addition to any other way I can be given notices, I agree that the placement of any notice on the craft for 2 weeks shall be deemed to be adequate notice to me of any communication under this agreement.
10. I release and indemnify the Club, its members and officers against any claim, loss, expense, injury, death or damage ('**Claim**') suffered by the craft or by any other property or by me or any other person in respect of the rack, its use by me or any other person, its maintenance and including any action taken to move the craft. This release and indemnity is absolute and unconditional and extends, without limitation, to any Claim arising from negligence of the Club, or its officers, members or contractors.
